Fundraising campaign for a valuable cause which supports the most underprivileged of the Magdalen Island community

Îles-de-la-Madeleine, April 1, 2020 – The Maritime Community of the Îles-de-la-Madeleine is mobilizing to support Entraide communautaire des Îles inc. in order to maintain essential services to the community for persons who are in need. During this difficult period associated with the pandemic, the emergency food services (food bank) and other primary needs must continue to be met.

Following the closure of non-essential businesses decreed by the Government of Quebec, an increase in demand has already been observed. According to the Director of the organization, Carmel Lapierre, a significant increase in the requests at the food bank and for support services to cover the basic needs of the most deprived is to be expected in the short term. Given the new situation, Entraide communautaire needs support, both financial and human, to continue to offer their services and to assist the community, including the services of the Fonds d'entraide de Grande-Entrée (Mutual aid fund of Grande-Entrée) which serves the people from Grande-Entrée and Grosse-Île.

On the one hand, a social fundraising campaign has been set up by the Maritime Community of the Îles-de-la-Madeleine in order to collect donations. The Maritime Community pledges to double the goal of \$8 000 to support the cause. For people whose situation enables them to help others, it is possible to contribute in three ways:
