

BYLAW 2010-005 REGARDING PARKING ALONG HEAD ROAD

WHEREAS a problem has been identified during the summer months with motorists parking along Head Road to attend Old Harry Beach, which is causing congestion along the roadway; and

WHEREAS motorists are parking along the edge of the cape bordering Head Road which is considered a heavy erosion zone and the safety of the public is in question; and

WHEREAS a parking area is provided by the Municipality for individuals attending Old Harry Beach; and

WHEREAS a notice of motion was given at a sitting of council held September 8, 2010; and

WHEREAS members of council declare having read this present bylaw;

THEREFORE

It is moved by Geraldine Burke
Seconded by Miles Clarke
And unanimously approved by the councillors present

THAT by-law 2010-005 is adopted, and that the following is ordered and decreed by the said by-law:

ARTICLE 1: PREAMBLE

The preamble of this present bylaw makes an integral part thereof.

ARTICLE 2: AREA PROHIBITED

Parking along the shoulder of Head Road, and any other area bearing a no-parking sign to this effect, is prohibited between May 15 and September 15, annually.

ARTICLE 3: AGREEMENT

The Municipality of Grosse Ile may conclude any agreement with the federal or provincial government or any private property owner in regard to the application of the dispositions of this present bylaw.

ARTICLE 4: APPLICATION

The council authorizes, in a general manner, the Sûreté du Québec to undertake criminal proceedings against persons contravening any provision outlined in this present bylaw and authorize the Sûreté to issue violation tickets as the case may be.

ARTICLE 5: INFRACTION

Any person who violates article 2 of this present bylaw is committing an infraction and is liable to pay a fine of forty (\$40.00) dollars per day the infraction is committed.

ARTICLE 6: COMING INTO FORCE

This present bylaw comes into force at the moment of its publication.
