Detailed report of the sitting of council held March 8, 2021 of the council of the Municipality of Grosse Ile.

CLOSED SESSION OF THE SITTING OF COUNCIL

WHEREAS public health order number 2020-177 issued on March 13, 2020 declared a

state of health emergency throughout the province of Quebec for an initial

period of ten (10) days;

WHEREAS subsequent public health orders extend this state of health emergency until

March 12, 2021;

WHEREAS public health order number 2020-029, dated April 26, 2020, from the

Minister of Health and Social Services, stipulates that when the law requires that a meeting must be public, it must be publicized as soon as possible by any means which allows the public to know the content of the discussions between the participants and the result of the deliberations of the members;

WHEREAS any municipal council may hold their meetings «in person» provided that

the public health guidelines can be respected, particularly those concerning social distancing and hygiene however, the public is not permitted to attend;

WHEREAS

in order to protect the health of the population; the members of council and municipal officers have decided that this sitting be a closed session and that the members of council and municipal officers be authorized to be present and to take part, deliberate and vote in person in the community conference room where the two (2) meter social distancing measure can be respected;

THAT the members of council hereby accept that this sitting of council is a closed session, and the members of council and municipal officers may participate in person in the community conference room where the two (2) meter social distancing measure can be respected.

2021 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS VOTING BY MAIL

- under the provisions of article 582.1 of the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities*, the minister may, by regulation, determine the manner in which a person is entered as an elector or qualified voter on the list of electors or referendum list in a capacity other than that of a domiciled person and may exercise the right to vote by mail;
- under the provisions of article 659.4 of the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities*, a resolution must be passed no later than July 1st of the calendar year in which a general election is to be held or, in the case of a by-election, not later than the fifteenth day after the day on which the council is informed of the polling date. In the case of a referendum poll, the resolution must be made during the sitting of the council during which the polling date is to be set. The same rules apply to a resolution passed to annul a previous resolution.

Councillor Felicia Clarke proposes:

TO use voting by mail for any person entered on the list of electors or referendum list as an elector or qualified voter in a capacity other than that of a domiciled person during any poll.

THAT Notification N2019-141 – Notice of Motion – Loan Bylaw 2019-011 – Professional services be hereby repealed.

TECQ – GAS TAX PROGRAM 2019-2023

- the Municipality has familiarized itself with the Guide regarding the Terms of payment of the government contribution within the Programme de la taxe sur l'essence et de la contribution du Québec (TECQ) for the years 2019 to 2023;
- the Municipality must respect the terms of this guide in order to receive the governmental contribution that was confirmed in a letter from the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing.

Councillor Nancy Clark proposes:

THAT the Municipality agrees to respect the terms of the guide that apply to the Municipality;

THAT the Municipality agrees to be the sole responsible body and releases the Canadian and Quebec Governments, their ministers, administrators, employees and delegates of any responsibility regarding claims for liability, damages, losses or costs of any kind that may be associated with injury or death of any person or for loss or damage to any immovable by a deliberate or negligent act resulting, directly or indirectly, from investments carried out with funds from the TECQ 2019-2023 program;

THAT the Municipality approves the content and agrees to send, to the Ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation, the enclosed work plan number 1, file number 1101042, regarding the aforementioned program as well as any other documentation required by the Ministry in order to receive the governmental contribution that was confirmed by letter from the Ministre des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation;

THAT the Municipality commits to reach the minimum capital threshold imposed on them for the five (5) years of the program;

THAT the Municipality agrees to inform the Ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation of any modifications that may be carried out to the schedule and work plans approved by this present resolution.

THAT the Municipality certifies by this present resolution that the enclosed schedule of works number 1, file number, 1101042, includes the true incurred costs and reflects the cost estimates of the work which is admissible.

CALL FOR TENDERS TECQ 2019-2023 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS – CHEMIN WIDE

The DG informs the councillors present:

- that the municipality makes an annual investment to the preservation of chemin Wide in order to maintain access for the population;
- considering the slope of the hill, gravel gets washed away after every rain storm;
- the product used during snow removal for the purpose of de-icing also disintegrates the structure of the road and leaves it being «mucky» and difficult to access;
- service providers, such as waste removal and fuel trucks are unable to climb the hill due to the condition of the road and therefore, refuse to use the road during the winter months;
- several single-family dwellings have been constructed on chemin Wide in the past few years;

Councillor Felicia Clarke proposes:

THAT the Director General, Janice Turnbull, be hereby authorized to proceed with a public call for tenders for professional services in order to prepare the plans and specifications and the supervion of work as well as the estimated costs of the work to carry out major road improvements on chemin Wide.
